8/24 CARES Act Module Training

The Fiscal Transfer Agent (FTA) data, systems, and distributed applications are being migrated to SBA's Capital Access Financial System (CAFS). As a result of this migration, Colson's 1502-related applications (1502 Dashboard and Connection) will be retired and replaced by the new 1502 Gateway within CAFS. The 1502 Gateway will contain the CARES Act module which will allow users to submit and report CARES Act-related loan and payment information.

To help familiarize users with the CARES Act module, the FTA will host a virtual training session on **Tuesday, August 24th** from **4-5pm ET**. To join the webinar, please use this [link](#).
