

Coming Soon: SBA's Modernized 1502 Reporting Module

Starting November 18, 2024, lenders can access the new 1502 Reporting module within the MySBA Loan Portal! The new module has been piloted with a small group of lenders over the past several months, and we are preparing for it to become **the required form of reporting by Summer 2025**.

What is the new 1502 Reporting module?

The new 1502 Reporting module makes 7(a) monthly lender reporting easier and more efficient.

Here's what we've improved:

- Fewer Fields: Less data for you to enter with only 9 fields per loan instead of 16
- Less Math: You enter the 100% portion, and the application calculates the guaranty
- Error Checking: The application flags errors upfront, improving accuracy
- New ACH Payment Option: Enter your banking information once and avoid wire transfer fees

When can we use the new application?

Although you can access the application **starting November 18**, we recommend following the training schedule below. Training will occur regionally each month in advance of the next reporting month.
