## **Settlement Express API**



#### What is an API?

An Application Programming Interface (API) is a software interface that allows applications to communicate (send and/or receive data) with each other.

# What is Settlement Express?

Settlement Express is a loan sale application accessible on the FTA Portal within SBA's Capital Access **Financial System** (CAFS). The broker initiates the sale of the guaranteed portion of an SBA 7(a) loan to the FTA by submitting the SBA Form 1086 (1086), Note, and Purchaser Confirmation of Sale loan details in Settlement Express.

Settlement Express API can be used as an alternative to the Settlement Express application to submit loan data.

#### What are the benefits of using an API?

APIs enable automation of workflows that help achieve greater productivity and increases overall process efficiency. They enable data sharing and reduce manual operations for users.

Additionally, Settlement Express API allows brokers to send one or more loan numbers with associated loan data directly into Settlement Express without having to go into the application.

#### Who can request access?

Your organization's Location ID must be tied to a broker dealer CAFS role to request access to Settlement Express API.

The Intercompany Service Agreement (ISA) Form can be found on the Wiki using <u>this link</u> and should be filled out and signed by the Vendor. The ISA sets the ground rules for accessing SBA 7a data.

Vendors then submit their completed ISA Form to SBA's Office of Performance and Systems Management (OPSM) at <u>CAFSTEST@sba.</u> gov. OPSM reviews and signs the ISA, and it is uploaded to SBA's Partner Information Management System (PIMS). The approved Vendor will receive a Partner ID, Vendor Software name, and Vendor Software ID.

#### What do I need to get started with using SBA APIs?

After completing the initial onboarding process, you will be instructed to create credentials for SBA's testing environment (catweb2.sba.gov). You are required to successfully test Settlement Express API in SBA's testing environment using the predefined technical method files here and follow the test scenarios documented in the ISA.

Test results should be submitted to <u>FTA@sba.gov</u>. After successful testing and validation, you will be granted access to SBA's production environment (caweb.sba.gov). Credentials in SBA's production environment will be the same as your existing CAFS Account credentials and are therefore subject to the same password resets and authentication requirements.


